Background <p>The Wesley, owned by The Methodist Church, operates two hotels in Camden</p> <p>The Wesley Euston - Established in 1999, this hotel features 99 guest rooms, 20 meeting rooms, a bar, and a restaurant, located near Euston Station.</p> <p>The Wesley Camden Town - Opened in 2022, this hotel offers 38 guest rooms in a BREEAM Excellent-rated building shared with Camden Methodist Church.</p>
<p>We manage The Wesley Euston on a 7-year lease and The Wesley Camden Town on a 50-year lease, taking responsibility for maintaining our buildings.</p>
